RESOLUTION AWARDING BID FOR TWO YEAR CONTRACT FOR DISPOSAL OF BULKY WASTE

WHEREAS, the City of Long Branch has the need to contract for disposal of Type 13 and 13C bulky waste collected by the Public Works Department from its curbside collection program; and

WHEREAS, through a fair and open process, the City has advertised to receive bids on November 1, 2016, for a two year contract for disposal of Type 13 and Type 13C bulky waste, and the following bids were received:

Republic Services d/b/a Marpal (\$78.00 per ton)	\$468,000
Mazza & Sons, Inc. (\$81.00 per ton)	\$486,000

WHEREAS, the bid documents were reviewed by the Purchasing Agent, and found to be in order; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Public Works Director and the Purchasing Agent that it is in the City's best interest to award a contract to **Republic Services d/b/a Marpal** as the low bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Long Branch has certified, in accordance with the Certification of Funds form attached hereto, that funds for these contracts are available in the 2016 Budget, Department of Public Works, Division of Solid Waste Disposal, **Appro. #6-01-057-521**, in the amount of \$20,000, with continuation of the contracts contingent upon provision of additional funds through appropriation transfer, emergency appropriation, and or additional funds in the 2017 adopted and future Budgets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Long Branch, that a two year contract be awarded to **Republic Services d/b/a Marpal** for disposal of up to 6,000 tons of Type 13 and 13C bulky waste at \$78.00 per ton, in accordance with the bid specifications and proposal, **for a sum not to exceed \$468,000.**



- Annual rental for a bathhouse shall be \$1,000.00
- Annual rental for a cabana house shall be \$2,750.00
- Rental of the Storage Locker, Bathhouses and Cabanas shall be for the beach season which is Memorial Day through Labor Day from dawn until dusk on a daily basis throughout the beach season
- Any violations of the rules governing the beaches of the City by a renter shall be subject to termination of the rental agreement at the sole

discretion of the City Business Administration which includes but is not limited to termination of the rental agreement and forfeiture of any monies paid as of that date


