This is in reference to an investigation conducted by the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) to inventory the existing centerline markings along Route NJ 36 in the City of Long Branch, County of Monmouth.

Staff of the Bureau of Traffic Engineering (BTE) has completed an investigation. Based on this investigation, the existing centerline markings are in compliance with current design standards. Therefore, the existing centerline markings along Route NJ 36 will remain as is.

Although the centerline markings will not change, NJDOT will still need to update our records. In order to do so, these updates must be legally established as "No Passing Zones", requiring a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO). An initial step in the TRO process is to receive a Resolution of Support (Concurrence) from the municipal governing body. The New Jersey Department of Transportation now requests that the Resolution of Concurrence be submitted within 90 days. Enclosed is a sample for your use.

Once this office is in receipt of the certified adopted Resolution of Concurrence from the City of Long Branch governing body, a Traffic Regulation Order will be promulgated.



**Scope of Work**

Branchport Avenue is a North-South two lane urban collector road within the City of Long Branch. It provides access to the commercial district on Broadway and provides access to Joline Avenue (NJDOT RT 36) and Atlantic Avenue (Monmouth County Route 29). The roadway primarily serves city residents and residents of the Borough of Oceanport. The sidewalks are heavily used by the children and families for walking to the residences and commercial services within the area.

The road has areas of moderate to severe pavement deterioration, including widespread surface distress cracks and sunken pavement. Utility trenches have also accelerated the deterioration of the pavement surface. Wear due to age, a salt air environment and salting in the winter months have also contributed to the deterioration of this section of the road. These conditions pose a safety hazard for the motorists.

The City is proposing to mill the existing roadway along the concrete curb line and pave 2" thick surface course. Areas of pavement with poor subgrade will be excavated and stabilized with new base material prior to surface course overlay. At each intersection, handicap ramps will be replaced and brought to current ADA standards. Where conditions are poor, segments of concrete curb and sidewalk will be replaced. The drainage system will be cleaned and repaired. Drainage inlets will be upgraded with castings that comply with current storm water management requirements. Incidental work will include resetting utility castings and restoration of areas disturbed by construction. The improvements will satisfy NJDOT design standards.

For this project, as with all paving projects constructed within the City, all work will be coordinated with the respective utility companies to insure that utility restoration or relocation will be implemented prior to commencement of construction. The City, under ordinance 297-49.1, will implement a five year moratorium on any utility work to protect roadway surface from unnecessary repair or opening.

Utility Trench Settlement

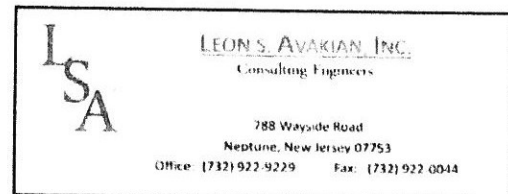

Branchport Avenue has areas of moderate to severe pavement deterioration, including widespread surface distress cracks due to heavy traffic, worn striping, and patchy utility trench repairs, all of which create a rough travel surface and allow puddles to form. These conditions pose a safety hazard for vehicular and bicycle traffic.

The proposed paving improvements will provide a smooth and stable roadway surface which will increase safety for motorists and bicyclists. The smooth pavement surface will also enable efficient movement of storm water from the roadway to drainage inlets and will prevent standing water and minimize the effects of freeze/thaw cycles. Additionally, the sidewalk and handicap improvements will eliminate uneven surfaces and allow access in compliance with ADA Regulations.
