FURTHER ORDERED that Wavell Thompson, Jayson Glasper, and Akeil Anderson shall provide proof to plaintiff that the notice is posted on all accounts; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Wavell Thompson, Jayson Gasper, and Akeil Anderson will not post anything contradicting this message. Plaintiff reserves the right to seek damages and counsel fees in the event of a breach by Wavell Thompson, Jayson Gasper, and Akeil Anderson.
