THIS MATTER having been brought by the court pursuant to plaintiff's June 6, 2022, verified complaint and order to show cause for temporary restraints and the plaintiff having appeared before the court on June 15, 2022, and

WHEREAS defendants Kevin J. Small, Semya Gill, and Jaylen Courten failed to appear;

IT IS on this 16th day of June 2022:

ORDERED that Kevin J. Small, Semya Gill, and Jaylen Courten are temporarily enjoined from "advertising, promoting, or encouraging" pop up beach parties within the City of Long Branch or other events contemplated by Long Branch Municipal Code 247-4 without first obtaining a special event permit, for the reasons stated on the record; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Kevin J. Small, Semya Gill, and Jaylen Courten shall post the following notice on all social media accounts which they own and/or operate:

"The Long Branch Beach Linkup on June 19th is CANCELLED. There will be no future "Beach Linkups," or "Pop Up Parties," or similar events without permits in the City of Long Branch. It is **ILLEGAL** to consume alcohol, tobacco, or marijuana on the Long Branch beach, boardwalk, or surrounding public area."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Kevin J. Small, Semya Gill, and Jaylen Courten will

not post anything contradicting this message; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Kevin J. Small, Semya Gill, and Jaylen Courten shall have leave to move for the dissolution or modification of the restraints until June 18, 2022, pursuant to R. 4:52-1(a).
